## What's AR? Who is Shurley? Where is LHS?

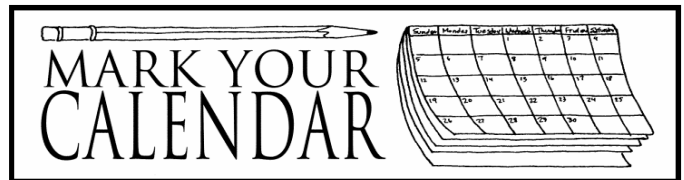
