It's been a time with a lot of changes and transitions the past two weeks and I want to thank the parents, student and staff for the positive way it has all been handled. I'm excited to be able to help during this time and I think A LOT has been accomplished in the last 9 days.

We have begun a very focused and sincere effort to work on behavior and attitudes towards others with the students. This is a school wide emphasis which currently involves a daily short written activity centered on the Bible verses on the front of your newsletter (grades K-2 do it orally). Each day your child has the opportunity to write at least one way that they lived according to those verses. They also have a space to explain how/when they could have done it better and there is a third space if they need to express any concerns to their teacher, to me or to an adult.

The focus verse will change each week and will be at the top of your newsletter every Friday for the following week. Please talk about this at home also. When you walk into our classrooms/the lunchroom/a ball game/ etc. at our school there should be a noticeable difference in the behaviors and attitudes of our kids compared with walking into any general public place. I have seen some very cool things happening already and can't wait to see the progress that will be coming!

We will be sending the newsletter home in written form again beginning this week. It will be sent home in the Friday envelope with the youngest family member. It will also be posted online on the school website if you prefer to read it that way.

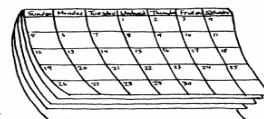
