- √ We also need volunteers for set up Thursday, October 7 at 5:30 p.m. in the FLC. We will also need Dad's at 5:30 to help set up tables.

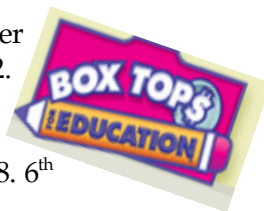
The Label Drive Results Are In!
