## Birthday Lunches

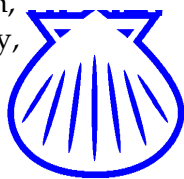
The November Birthday Lunches with our Pastors will be celebrated with students in Kindergarten through Fifth Grade on Wednesday, November 3.

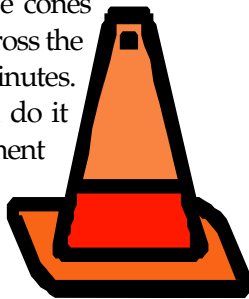

We will be administering the Iowa Tests of Basic Skills for our 2<sup>nd</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade students beginning on Monday November 8<sup>th</sup>. Please try to avoid any unnecessary absences on the part of your child for that week.
